Where is EAC offered?

No matter where you are, you can get the help you need through our network of counseling offices throughout the U.S. and Canada.

How much does it cost?

Your employer pays for a specific number of sessions per year with EAC for you and your covered family members. Contact your Human Resources department or EAC to determine how many sessions are covered. If you are referred to an outside resource for further counseling or other treatment, you will be responsible for any fees not covered by insurance.

Is EAC voluntary?

Yes. EAC is voluntary, unless your employer requires you to attend EAC as a condition of continued employment.

Will using EAC jeopardize my job?

No. We're here to help you do your job as effectively as possible – so you can become even more valuable to your employer.

Is EAC confidential?

EAC is a confidential service. No information, written or verbal, will be given to your employer or anyone else without your written consent.
